

# Quarterly Treasurer's Report for January-April 2020

## Financial Snapshot

Our bank balance as at July 3, 2020 was \$41,649.05.

Overview of some of our recurring costs:

- ❖ Insurance policy (Liability and Directors & Officers Cover) – \$2,354 per year
- ❖ Storage Facilities - \$1,980 per year
- ❖ Website Services – Annual service fee: \$2,073.60
- ❖ Bookkeeping Services – Debbie Daniels at \$35 per hour
- ❖ AAI Telephone – we pay \$79.53 per month
- ❖ Town Crier – It cost \$260.67 per month for twelve 1/8 page ads and 2 full pages in the bi-annual Explore Idyllwild Directory.
- ❖ Cost of printing the 2020 Gallery Guide, 2,000 copies, \$499.96

## Courtyard Gallery (CYG)

These are the final 2020 CYG Figures. The gallery closed at the end of June having not been open since the end of March, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We no longer pay rent or electricity and are awaiting the refund of our Security Deposit from Village Center Partners.

## Event Financials

### Grants Awarded (January-December 2020)

A \$250 Grant was approved to purchase art kits for distribution by the Help Center to families registered with them.

#### Reed Foundation Grant

A portion of the unused Reed Foundation grant was spent to purchase 40 Take Home Kits for Idyllwild Help Center - \$538.76.

We have used \$910.13 of this grant to purchase art kits for distribution in the wider Idyllwild community.

### **Grants Received (January-December 2020)**

We received a \$1,000 Grant from Youth Grant Makers for use for the Home School Art Classes. We have yet to receive the check. It is delayed because we cannot meet for the photo op with the check due to COVID-19.

During May, 2020, Donna Elliot applied for a 2020 \$10,000 Reed Foundation Grant. We will be notified during July, 2020.

On July 6, 2020, Donna Elliot applied to the Riverside County Inland Empire Community Foundation for a \$10,000 Non-Profit Assistance Grant. Notification on August 27, 2020.
