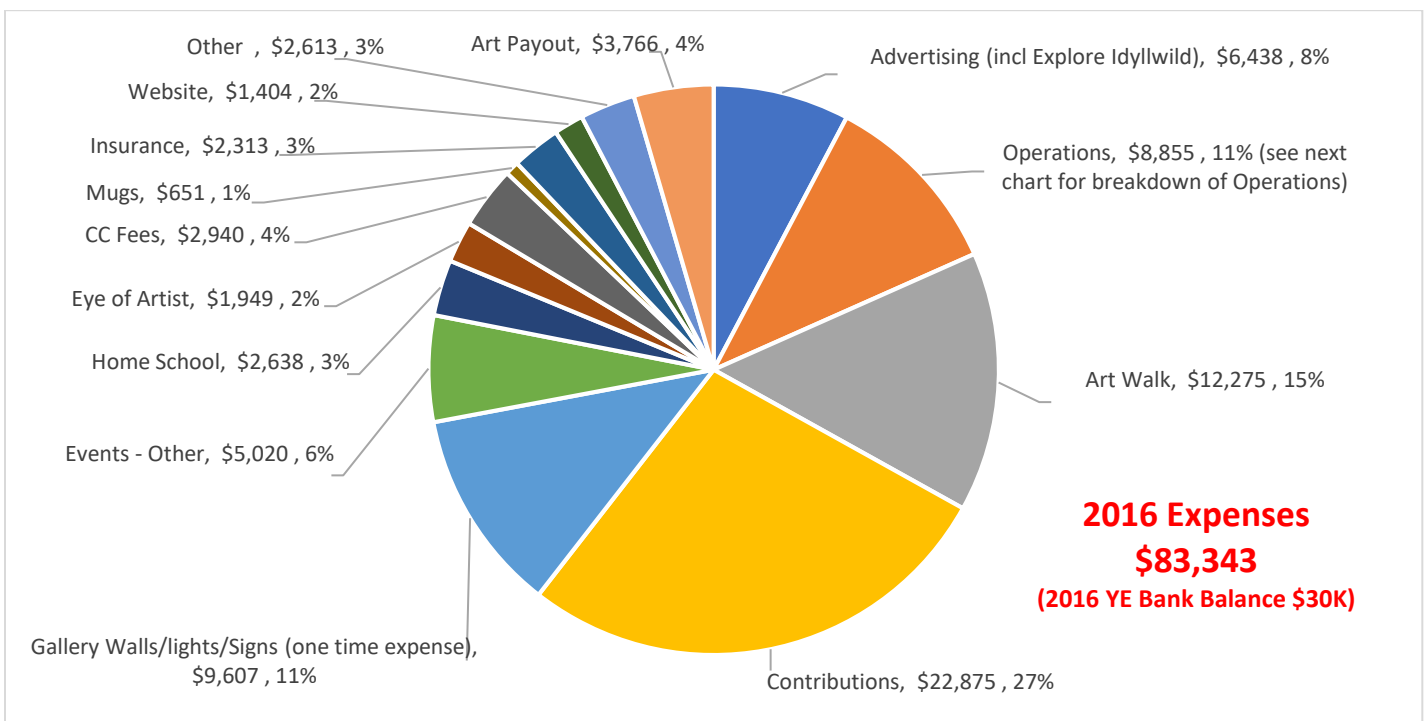
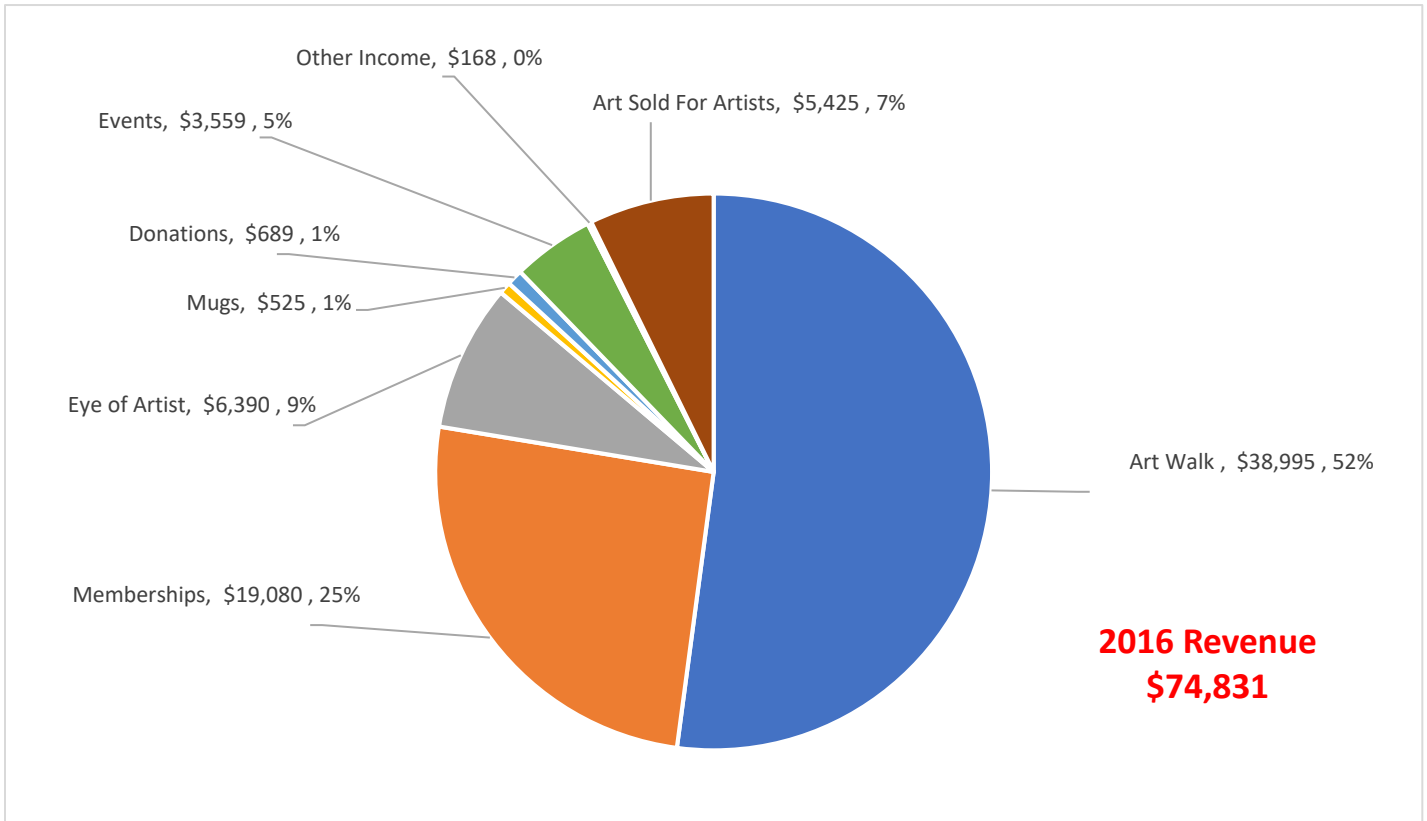
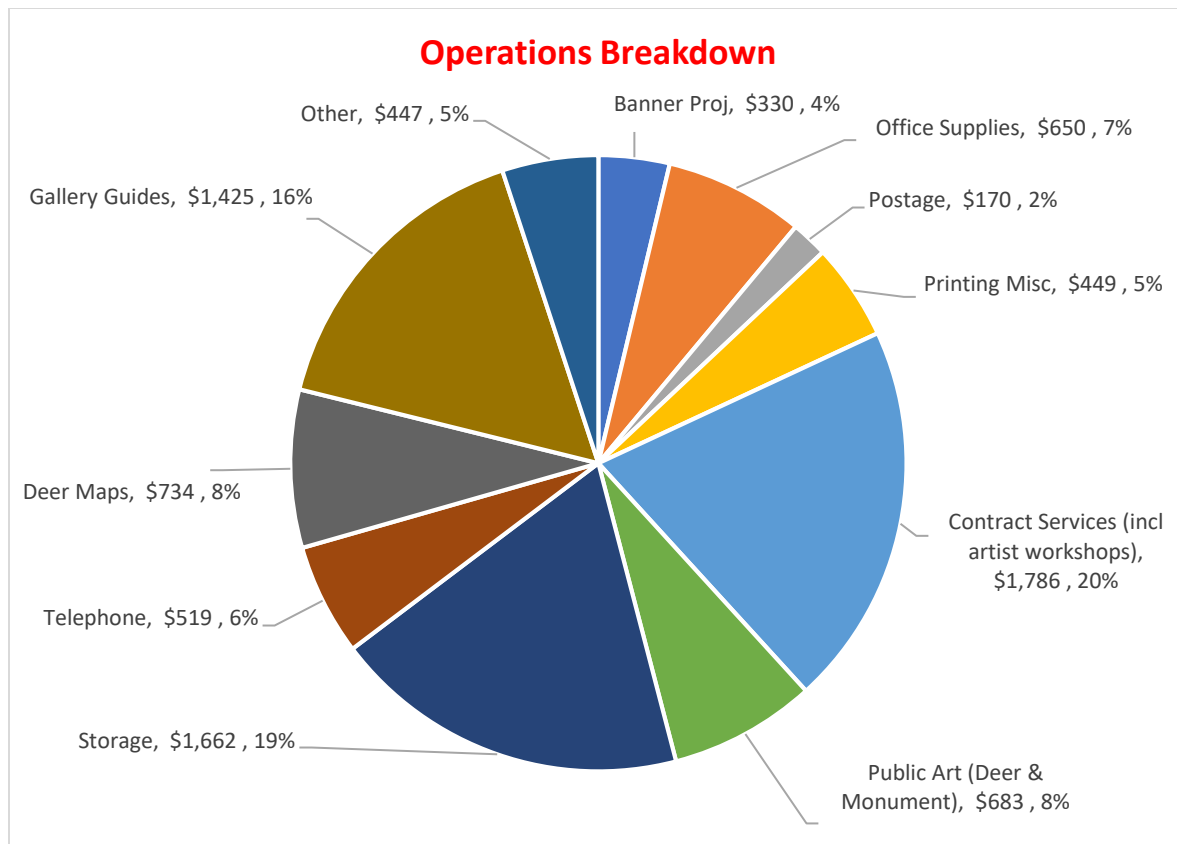


# 2016 Financial Snapshot

### Definition of a Nonprofit Organization

A **nonprofit organization** (NPO) (also known as a non-business entity) is an **organization** whose purpose is something other than making a profit. A nonprofit organization is often dedicated to furthering a particular social cause or advocating for a particular point of view. No part of the **organization's** income is distributed to its members, directors, or officers. To qualify for the tax-exempt status, it must further religious, scientific, charitable, educational, literary, public safety or cruelty prevention causes or purposes. It must generate some public benefit also.

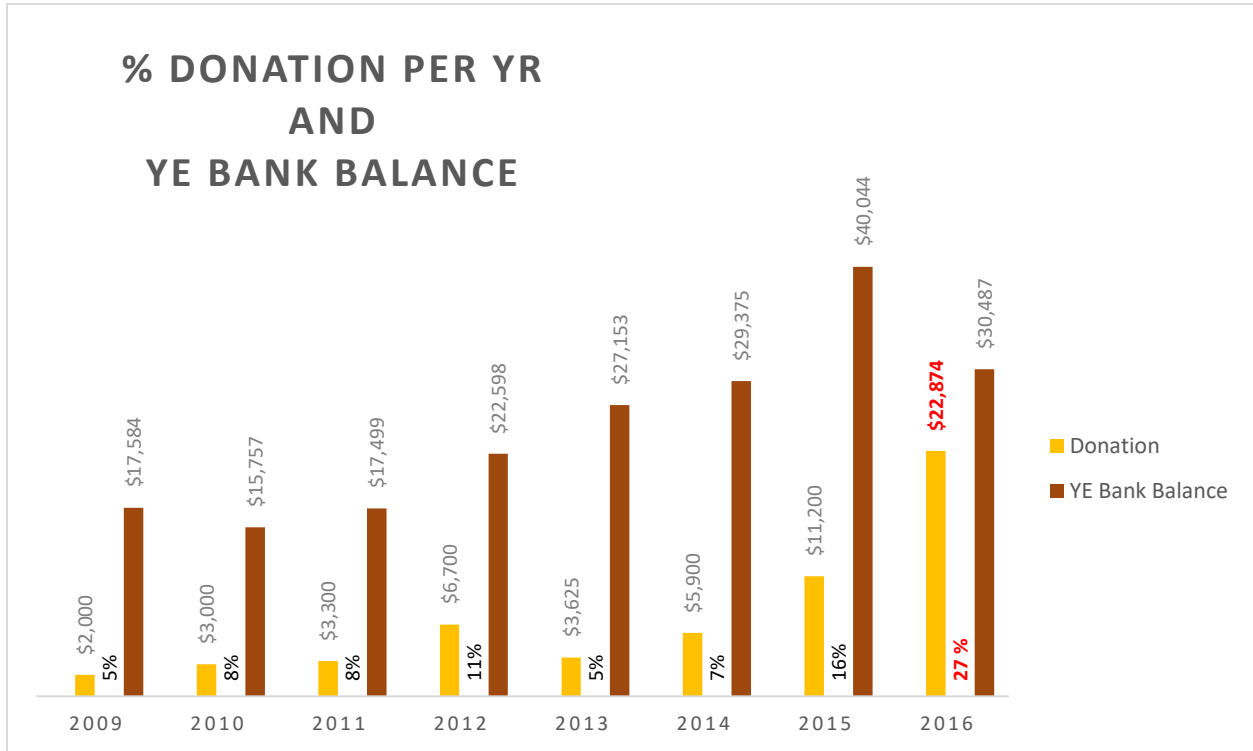
